HOW TO TAKE PART IN THE SHOW

- **The show isn't just for Garden club members** (please read the rules on the back).
- **You do not have to be an expert!** There are sections for everything and it's all fun.
- Start planning early! Crafts take a while to make, fruit and veg to grow and preserves always taste better after they have matured a bit. So, pick a section you fancy and focus on that.
- On the day – Bring along your prized possessions between 11am and 1pm. Your entry will be listed on the paperwork, a slip attached to it and if necessary (depending on class), will be placed on a paper plate, provided by the club. The entry will then be taken away by a club member and placed on the tables in the correct section. You can then partake in idle banter with fellow exhibitors over whose will win, outside of the hall.
- You will be asked if you are a garden club member. You do not have to be a member to take part, this is because we have a trophy open to members only, on points. You are very welcome to join the club (£5) and take part in trying to win this trophy too.
- **Its free to enter** (see rules for how many entries).
- The show then opens its doors at 2pm for the public and exhibitors to enjoy the show. See if you have won a placing, see what you were up against, enjoy refreshments, the awards, our hugely popular raffle and the auction of produce.
- You are welcome to take your entry back after the prizegiving or donate anything to the show auction.
- Its really that easy, so let's keep this great tradition going and have great fun.

5. **The judge's decision will be final.**
